SAMPLE ASSIGNMENT

QC's step-by-step program will take you through every aspect of the floral design process. The course assignments are devised to put you into the floral designer's role, in real-world hands-on scenarios that help develop your creative skills as a professional floral designer.

Unit A Assignment 5 - *Designing a Vase Arrangement*

In this assignment you'll design a simple vase arrangement to show your tutor your current skill level when working with flowers. You'll use this as a starting point to improve your skills throughout this course.

You can use any flowers of your choosing to complete this design, as long as you include the four flower forms (line, mass, filler and form) and foliage in your design. You'll need 10-15 stems total to complete your design. You may use any type of vase that you have at home. If you feel comfortable working with floral design mechanics, such as a tape grid or floral foam, you may do so. However, you are not required to use any specific mechanics to complete your vase arrangement.

Before you begin, you'll need to gather your supplies. For this assignment, you'll need:

- A vase
- Flowers and foliage (10-15 stems total)
- A floral knife and/or floral scissors
- Design mechanics (if applicable)
- A bin for flower waste

Note that when creating your simple vase arrangement for this assignment, you may need to trim the stems to fit in your container. Handle sharp cutting tools with care to avoid cuts and other injuries.

You'll need to take photos of your work to share with your tutor. You may use a digital camera or a smartphone to take your photos. Keep the following tips in mind to help you take clear images of your work:

- Photograph your arrangement in bright and/or natural light
- Take the photo in front of a blank wall or clear backdrop with no clutter so that your tutor can clearly see the design
- Ensure your entire arrangement is in clear focus without any blurring

- Photograph the arrangement showing all of the flower blossoms, using the framing shown on the right. Save the photo to your computer with the name, "Vase Design Overhead."
- Photograph the arrangement from the side, including the vase in the frame, using the framing shown on the right. Save the photo to your computer with the name, "Vase Design Side View"
